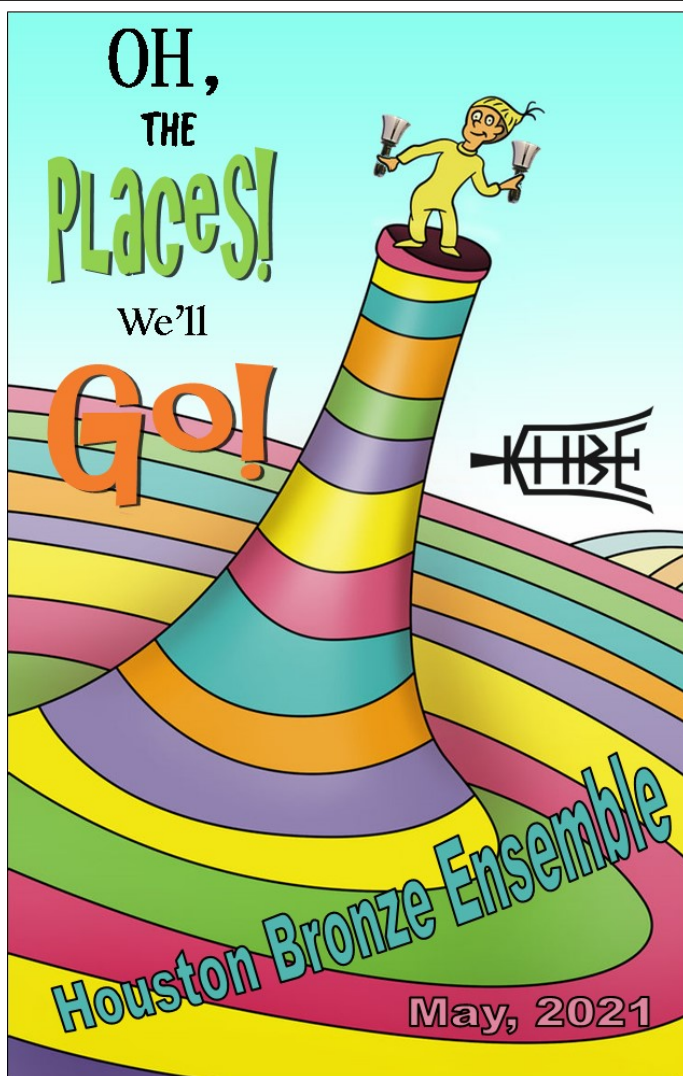

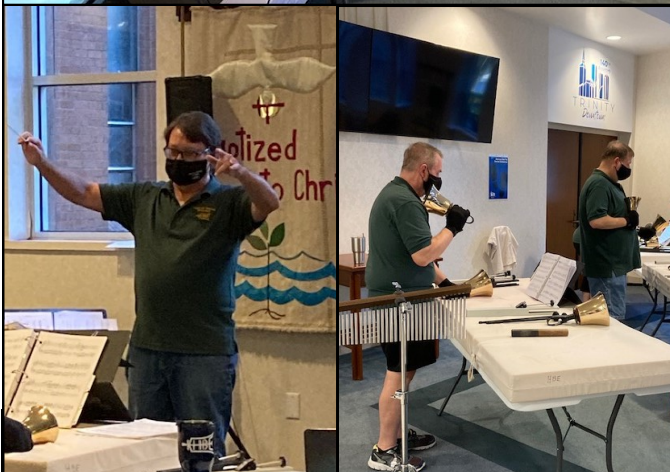

This fall Houston Bronze was contacted by Handbell Musicians of America about joining, as the performing group, a virtual composition masterclass that was to be offered by them with Jason Krug as instructor. We were honored to be invited and of course, said yes. Because of Covid, everything was conducted via Zoom. Once we became involved in the process, everything happened quickly. We received most of the beginning drafts from the composers via Jason on Sunday, November 8. Copies were quickly made and sent to ensemble members to mark and come prepared to rehearse and then record them at our regular Tuesday night rehearsal on Nov. 10. All recordings were made via iPhone. These recordings were then sent to Jason. Two members of HBE met via ZOOM with Jason and the composers on Friday November 11. The composers heard their compositions for the first time performed on handbells. The composers received comments from Jason and HBE and then returned to the “drawing board” to make edits. On Sunday at about 4:00, we started receiving and printing on site the edits made by the composers with Jason’s tutelage. One piece was seen for the first time on Sunday. We were able to rehearse the changes briefly before the performance began via ZOOM. This was a great experience for us. ## About the Houston Bronze Ensemble

The Houston Bronze Ensemble is a professional, auditioned, handbell ensemble made up of musicians from the greater Houston area. Known as Houston's premier handbell choir, the ensemble performs regular concerts in the winter and spring as well as at community events, regional and national handbell events, weddings, and private parties. In 2014 HBE had the honor of performing with the Houston Symphony. The group plays a wide variety of musical genres, always with the goal of EXCELLENCE.

Founded in 1988, Houston Bronze Ensemble was started as an avenue for Houston area handbell directors to have a place to ring. A lunchtime meeting with Jeff Weiss, Christine Anderson and Hart Morris in attendance and with only a napkin to write the names of those who might be interested is what started it all. The rest, as they say, is history. In the fall of 1988, Hart Morris became the first director of Houston Bronze. After Hart moved to Tennessee, the ensemble rang under the direction of Margaret R. Tucker. In the 1995 season, the group rang ensemble style with various ringers, including G.W. Shepherd, Andrew Bowen, and David VanderMeer, directing the ensemble. Conductors since then have included David VanderMeer, Dolan Bayless, Ben Harris, Ruth Seiwel and James Roberts. Bill Nave was appointed the artistic director in August, 2014.

Houston Bronze recognizes the importance of investing in the future of handbell ringing. We offer a variety of educational opportunities designed to meet the unique needs of churches and schools who wish to build or improve their handbell program. Workshops designed to meet the specific needs of a choir, mini concerts, and petting zoos are a sample of what we provide to the Houston area handbell community. Houston Bronze also offers scholarships to students wishing to attend College Ring-In, an event sponsored by Handbell Musicians of America.

Whether it is through a concert, playing at your wedding, party, private or community event, conducting a workshop for your ensemble, or presenting an educational program for your school, we would love to share our art with you!
