

Meet Bill Brusick

One of the selections on our Christmas program this year will be a newly arranged version of "We Wish You a Merry Christmas". This was arranged by

our own Bill Brusick. Bill joined the HBE Board of Directors in September of 2012. He has offered us good counsel over the last 5 years and we appreciate all he has done for us. He is a noted composer and arranger of both sacred and secular music with over 100 cataloged works for orchestra, band, chamber ensembles, solo instruments and chorus. In 2014 Houston Bronze commissioned his first handbell composition, "Selah" which premiered at HBE's 25th Anniversary Gala on May 3, 2014. It was also performed at Pinnacle, a national handbell conference, held in Dallas in the summer of 2015. https://youtu.be/dFNIbqm89hk This performance was recorded at our Pinnacle Send-Off Concert in July, 2015.

This music box sounding arrangement of "We Wish You a Merry Christmas", to be premiered on December 1, 2017, was conceived on his way home from a HBE board meeting in July of this year. Bill Nave, HBE artistic director, had mentioned the need for a concert closer at the board meeting. All other selections for the concert were made. On Bill Brusick's way home from the board meeting, the music began playing in his head and once home he put it into Finale. It wasn't long before he sent this delightful arrangement to us.

Bill serves as the organist/pianist, choir director and overseer of music programs for <u>Trinity Lutheran Church and School</u> in Spring, TX. In 2007, Houston Bronze had the pleasure of ringing on the Trinity concert series for the first time. We have continued to play there each year and will be there again on April 15, 2018.

Thank you, Bill, for this delightful arrangement and for all you have done to support our ensemble over the past ten years. You are a true Friend of Houston Bronze.

Houston Bronze College Ring-In Scholarship Program

The Houston Bronze Ensemble is happy to announce that we will once again be granting two scholarships to college students who are attending the Handbell Musicians of America College Ring-In 2018 that is to be held at Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey on January 3-6, 2018. Each scholarship will be for \$100.00, covering the cost of registration. Each scholarship will be granted in the form of a reimbursement once the event and requirements of the scholarship are met. All other expenses (music, lodging, meals, transportation to and from the festival site, sightseeing, etc.) are the responsibility of the recipient. Preference will be given to applicants from the greater Houston metropolitan area. Secondly, we will consider applicants from the entire state of Texas and beyond.

Requirements:

- Be accepted by HMA into College Ring-In.
- · Be a student at a college or university.
- · Submit scholarship application to HBE by December 1, 2017.
- · Post on the Houston Bronze Ensemble Facebook page while attending the event.
- · Recipients are expected to submit a brief follow-up report of their experience at College Ring-In with permission for HBE to use this information on our website and on our Facebook page.




A Day of Celebration!

On Thursday, October 12, the partnership expanded to include the bell choir from St. Pius X High School under the direction of Marge Harris when they traveled to Brookwood to present a smart board and projector. These tools will bring Brookwood's music delivery system into the 21st century and eventually replace the handwritten scrolls they currently use. There are still more hurdles to maneuver but we are moving in the right direction thanks to this very generous gift from St. Pius. To celebrate this gift, members of all 3 groups joined together to enjoy cookies and ringing some pieces together. It truly was a "Day of Celebration!"

The next hurdle on this path to updating Brookwood's music delivery system is inputting all of their music into the smart board software. Many hours of data entry lie ahead! Ultimately, we would like to either find an existing program or someone to write a new program that would have the capability of converting a piece of sheet music into the format they use. About The Houston Bronze Ensemble

The Houston Bronze Ensemble is a professional, auditioned, handbell ensemble made up of musicians from the greater Houston area. The founders of HBE, Jeff Weiss, Christine Anderson, and Hart Morris, met for lunch one day in 1988 looking for a way for Houston area handbell directors to have a place to play. They began by writing on a napkin the names of the people who might want to be a part of this ensemble. This was our beginning. In the fall of 1988 Hart Morris became the first director of Houston Bronze. After Hart moved to Memphis, Tennessee, the ensemble rang under the musical direction of arranger and composer Margaret (Maggi) R. Tucker until 1994. During the 1995 season, the group rang ensemble style with various ringers, including G.W. 'Dub' Shepherd, Andrew Bowen and David Vander-Meer, directing the ensemble. Conductors since then included David VanderMeer, Dolan Bayless, Ben Harris, Ruth Seiwell and James Roberts. Bill Nave was appointed the artistic director in August 2014.

The ensemble celebrated its 25th Anniversary year in 2014. In December 2014, Houston Bronze Ensemble was honored with an invitation to perform with the Houston Symphony as a part of their Family Concert Series. In July 2015, the ensemble was invited to and performed at Pinnacle 2015 held in Dallas, TX.

The ensemble rehearses every Tuesday evening with a focus on excellence in precision and expression. The ensemble plays a variety of genres of music but always with the goal of excellence.

Houston Bronze Ensemble holds a 501(c)(3) non-profit status.
